GERMANY

Aventinus The Schneider brewery was established in 1872 and this is the world's oldest top-fermenting wheat doppelbock, light and dangerously refreshing for 8% ABV \$7.50 16.9oz

Erdinger Hefe-Weizen A perfect example of a German Wheat beer. Simply fantastic \$4.50 16oz

Weihenstephan Kristall Weissbier The source of its pearling, effervescent taste is the secret fermentation process developed especially for crystal wheat beer. \$4.50 16oz

Tucher Kristall Weizen A classic German wheat beer with the yeast filtered, resulting in a crystal clear wheat beer with great flavor and a light crisp body. \$4.00 16oz

Spaten Oktoberfest The folks at Spaten have been brewing great marzens for hundreds of years, and in my opinion they do it best \$3.50 12OZ

Spaten Premium Lager This traditional German lager is what most American beers try to imitate. Crisp, golden, refreshing, with flavor, no rice or corn in this beer. \$3.75 12OZ

Franziskaner Dunkel-Weiss Dunkel-Weiss is a classic dark wheat beer. Malty sweetness and a medium body make this the richer older brother of the Hefe \$4.50 16 oz

Franziskaner Hefe-Weiss Another great beer from Munich, Franziskaner is a member of the Spaten family of beers continuing 600 plus years of brewing excellence and setting the standard for Hefes for centuries. \$3.75 12OZ

BELGIUM

Chimay White (Triple) An authentic Trappist beer. The beer's flavor comes from the smell of hops: above all it is the fruity notes of muscat and raisins that give this beer a particularly attractive aroma. \$6.75 11.2OZ

Hoegaarden Created in the village of Hoegaarden in Belgium; this beer is brewed using the traditional ingredients of water, yeast, wheat, hops, coriander and dried Curacao orange peel. \$4.00 12OZ

Delirium Tremens Tremens is sweet, high alcohol, bubbly, and absolutely overwhelmingly delicious. The unique flavor of Tremens is due to the use of three types of yeast in the brewing process. 8.5% ABV \$6.75 11.2OZ

Piraat The flavor is so complex and so rich that every swallow conjures up new associations. Note the spicy light sweetness, which is richly balanced with the robust bitterness of the hops. It is an adventure of a beer, a treat. \$6.00 11.2OZ

new Gulden Drak another great beer from the Van Steenberg Brewery, Gulden Drak essentially is a Belgian Barley Wine, but goes so far beyond the category that it is a beer without a category fitting its character. At 10.5% ABV you should be careful of the golden dragon named for the statue at the top of the clock tower in Ghent. \$6.00 11.2OZ

Tripel Karmeliet Still brewed from the 1679 recipe originating in the Carmeliet monastery this fine brew uses three types of grain – wheat, barley, & oats. And very well may be one of the tastiest tripels ever brewed. \$7.00 11.2OZ

Lindemans: Framboise (raspberry), & Peche (peach) \$15.00 \$5.00
A fantastic selection of fruit flavored Lambics from Belgium. Lambics do not resemble your average beer, they tend to be more flavorful, full of carbonation, and absolutely irresistible. 25.4 oz 8 oz glass
