<u>Avery Hog Heaven (CO)</u> Wow, altogether different from most Barley Wine style ales; in this ale bitter, citrusy, and malty taste meet a caramely sweetness and a robust finish.	\$9	22OZ

<u>Hoegaarden</u> Created in the village of Hoegaarden in Belgium; this beer is brewed using the traditional ingredients of water , yeast , wheat , hops , coriander and dried Curaçao orange peel .	\$4	12oz
<u>Piraat</u> The flavor is so complex and so rich that every swallow conjures up new associations. Note the spicy light sweetness, which is richly balanced with the robust bitterness of the hops. It is an adventure of a beer, a treat.	\$6	11.2oz
